6. **Discussion questions**: If you are watching alone, please consider calling someone this week to discuss your answers. If you are not sure who to call, please text me (Ben 814-880-3049) and we will help you connect with someone. (Ephesians 5:18-21)
 - a. Why is drunkenness bad?
 - b. How would you contrast being drunk with being filled with the Holy Spirit? What does it mean to be sober minded?
 - c. What might it look like to invite Jesus into every part of your life? Alternatively, what might it look like to place a, “keep out” sign on certain parts of your life?
 - d. What does a life fueled by the Holy Spirit look like? What might it look like to have a life fueled by people pleasing, good intentions, guilt or striving?
 - e. How is a sail being filled different than filling a jar or a box? How might this relate to the Holy Spirit?
 - f. What might verse 19 teach us about the necessity of Christian community?
 - g. What might it look like to redeem music for the glory of God?
 - h. How might thankfulness help a person to see reality and abide in truth?
 - i. What can we learn from Jesus about submission?
 - j. Why might someone suggest that we can not experience the resurrection power of Jesus without going through the cross?
 - k. What does it look like for a Christian to take up their cross and follow Jesus? (Matthew 6:24)
