6. **Discussion questions**: If you are watching alone, please consider calling someone this week to discuss your answers. If you are not sure who to call, please text me (Ben 814-880-3049) and we will help you connect with someone. (Ephesians 5:22-25)
  - a. How should faith in Christ influence the home? What type of “homework” do you have to do?
  - b. Why does Paul address women?
  - c. What is the significance of the word “submit” not appearing in the Greek in verse 22?
  - d. How might you respond to someone that suggests that submission is inferiority? How should Christ and his sacrifice influence our perspective on submission?
  - e. How should a woman respond to her husband if he asks her to do something sinful? In what ways is Acts 5:27-29 instructive?
  - f. What is the significance of the word “for” at the beginning of verse 23?
  - g. In what ways is loving submission like tennis?
  - h. What should a husband and wife do if they disagree?
  - i. What does it look like for a husband to love his wife?
  - j. How does Jesus’ death on the cross influence the way Christians view love?
  - k. In what ways is Jesus a model of manhood? How does Jesus differ from the prevailing views of manhood in America?
  - l. Why might someone suggest that the exhortations given to husbands and wives in Ephesians 5:22-25 are two ways of looking at the same thing? Do you agree or disagree? Why?
